1. Project Proposal – Please describe the resource concern, what will be done & who will do the work.

At our Wolf Run property we irrigate 40a of alfalfa with valid water rights. We utilize ditch water, and store it in two ponds, for when the ditch flow drops. This works as a cistern to gather water between cuttings. When the ditch water runs low, we pump out of our lower pond, and refill it via gravity from the upper one. During high ditch flow, or when hay is being cut, we refill the ponds. The upper pond and pipeline between them, was nracs approved when built a decade ago. The existing 3" pipeline in a gravity situation doesn't keep up with the rate of depletion when irrigating out of the lower pond. We need to replace the 3" pipe with 6" ADS pipe, to fully utilize the upper ponds water storage purpose.

We will do the work ourselves. The pipeline is 1600'.

Pipe is around \$8/ft \$12,800

Backhoe work at \$120/hr. 50 hours \$6000

Total project cost is \$18,800

2. Describe how this project will address the resource concern or provide an overall benefit that this project will provide to the watershed.

This project will benefit the watershed by increasing the utilization of our existing water. Using the water we have onsite will decrease the amount of water that needs to be diverted from eight mile creek to satisfy the water rights and crop needs. This project also fixes a miscalculation from a previous water conservation project.

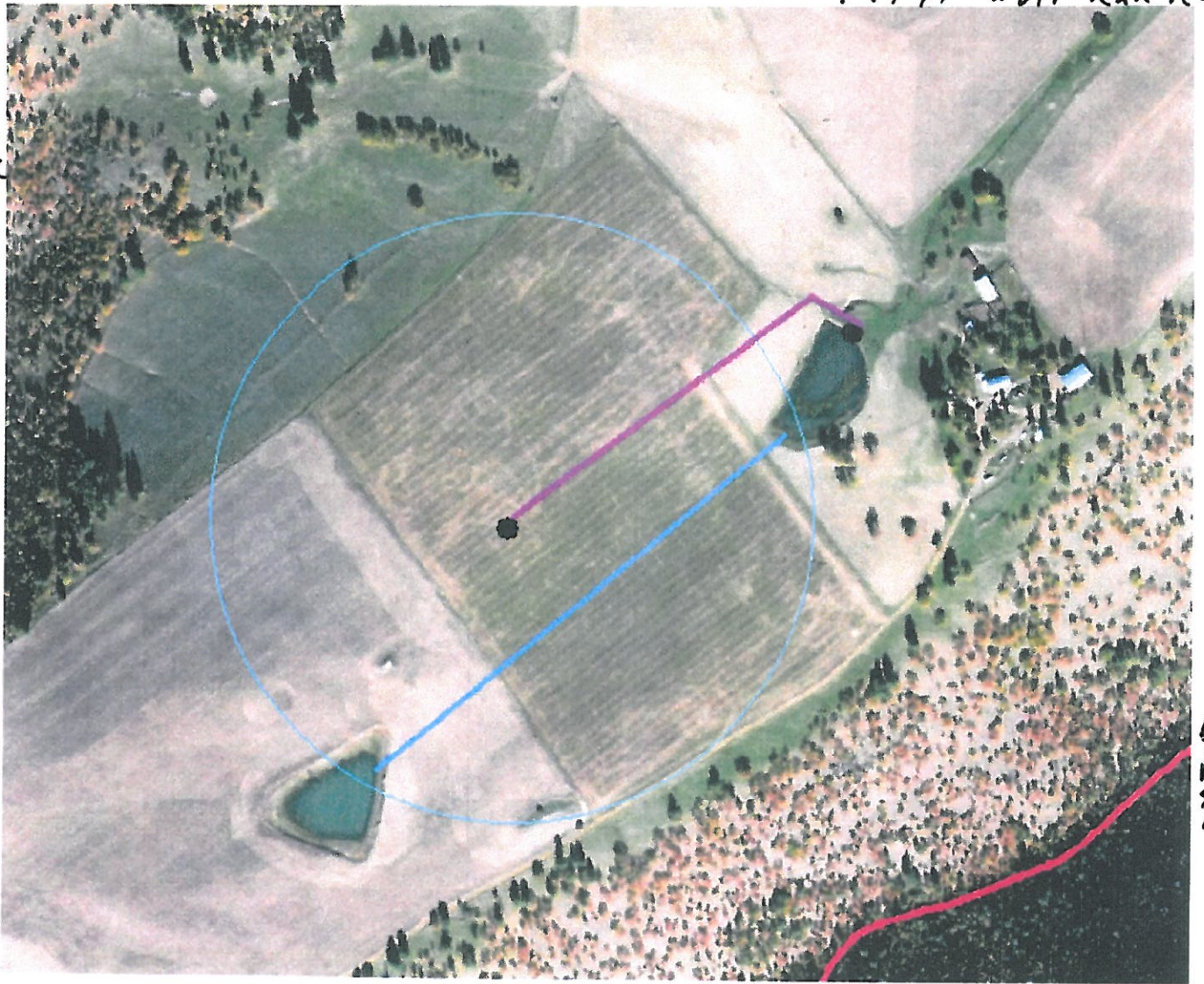
